



18th century cushion cut diamond circular cluster ring, c.1770,

the principal diamond, approximately 1 ct, within a graduated two row border of smaller cushion cuts, cut-down collet set, the close set underside inscribed with a cypher possibly MYL, and bright-cut engraved scalloped border with zigzag band, mounted in silver and gold, simple gold shank of faceted section
