Pair of 19th century single stone old mine cut diamond, gold and enamel earrings, probably English c.1865, the diamonds of approximately 2.75cts in all,

coronet claw set in raised bevelled gold frames of hexagonal outline, with engraved fluting and accenting, black enamel darts giving a flowerhead petal effect, later gold peg and hinged clip fittings
