



Early 19th century cushion cut diamond cluster ring, c.1810, the larger rectangular cushion cut landscape set,

within a border of double-eight cut diamonds, smaller diamonds between, close cut down collet set in silver and gold, curved underbezel, gold trifurcated shoulders with floral and foliate detail joining at a shell motif, simple shank back

Cluster 13.0 x 12.8mm

Central diamond spread 5.2 x 4.1mm
