Early 20th century amethyst and gold pendant necklace, c.1910, forming also a shorter necklace and a bracelet,

the gold foliate link chain of Egyptianesque design, spaced by circular faceted amethysts, suspending from a central line to front and hung with a large pear shaped amethyst, this with rose cut top and faceted pavilion, the circular stone of brilliant cut, all open collet set, the back of the necklace, with five-petal flowerheads, detaching to form the bracelet, bolt ring clasps

Length as single longer necklace: 63.5cm / 25"

Length of pendant line to front 9.5cm / 3¾"

Length as shorter necklace 43cm / 17"

Pear amethyst approximately 30.0 x 17.0 x 12.5mm

Round amethysts approximately 11-12 x 17mm
