Early 19th century graduated vari-coloured gem set collet necklace, c.1830, including emeralds, rubies, sapphires, garnets, pearls and other gemstones, largely round or cushion facettled, open cut down collet set in silver and gold.

The broad variety comprising from the clasp box:

Emerald; probably white sapphire; opal; pearl; pyrope garnet; chrysoberyl; lapis lazuli; opal; orangey-brown zircon; probably aquamarine; pearl; ruby; cat's eye quartz; probably yellow sapphire; light orangey-brown diamond; emerald; corallium rubrum; probably amethyst/rose quartz; turquoise; possibly blue topaz; pink sapphire; green tourmaline; cat's eye quartz; amethyst; pink spinel; chrysoberyl; ruby; amethyst; pinkish-brown zircon; sapphire; pink topaz; almandine garnet; sapphire; peridot; pink tourmaline; amethyst; possibly orange zircon or garnet; pearl; emerald; sapphire; pyrope garnet; sapphire; grossular garnet; pink sapphire; amethyst; almandine garnet; moonstone; chrysoberyl; aquamarine; pink tourmaline; turquoise; pink topaz; tinted diamond; corallium rubrum; demantoid garnet; probably yellow sapphire; moonstone; aquamarine; amethyst; pyrope garnet; diamond; pearl; opal; turquoise; ruby; probably yellow sapphire and opal
