**18th century emerald and diamond floral and foliate cluster suite, French c.1760, comprising a necklace, two brooches and a pair of earrings,**

of openwork design and set throughout with rose cut diamond flowerheads and calibre cut emerald foliage, the necklace with pendant section to the front composed of a drop shaped diamond flower within an emerald and diamond floral and foliate wreath, a bird hung below looking back over its shoulder, a principal diamond flowerhead to the top and crossed foliate branch motif in between, the necklace formed of panels of diamond flowerheads and emerald foliage, the brooches each with diamond flowerhead within an emerald leaf and diamond bud border, the earrings with diamond floral drop with emerald accents around, below similar circular tops with central cartouche panel of flowers and leaves in between, all close set in silver, original 18th century fitted case
