Set of two early 19th century vari-coloured gem and diamond cluster bracelets, French c.1820, forming a choker necklace,

each spaced by cushion cut coloured gem stones and principal diamond, in rose cut diamond borders, cut-down collet set, joined by two row rose cut diamond bar links with diamond double C scroll motif in between, the shorter bracelet with five larger stones including sapphire, amethyst and green zircon, the longer bracelet with six smaller stones including the principal diamond, sapphire and garnet, open set and mounted in silver and gold, French assaymarks for gold and with French workshop mark for CG.

Coloured gem map:

The larger bracelet, from the box end, the gemstones comprise: green zircon; amethyst; citrine; sapphire and lemon citrine.

The smaller bracelet, from the box end, the gemstones comprise: pyrope garnet; sapphire; peridot; diamond; yellow topaz and sapphire (image shows the order with the diamond at the end; this bracelet has two clasps and the order can be changed).
