19th century diamond tremblant hanging spray of flowers brooch, Vever, Paris c.1860,
designed as a trailing S curve stem set along supporting graduated flowerheads, three mounted en
tremblant, each with five, six and seven pointed leafy-petals and with single stone to centre, the
diamonds of cushion and old brilliant cut, the lower section articulated on a pendant loop and detachable
for wear as two separate brooches, the larger one with the tremblant flowers, open set in silver and
gold, signed 'VEVER' and with French assaymarks
Length overall 21cm / 8 1/4"
