**Set of four George III parcel gilt silver shell salts by John Craddock & William Reid, London 1818, together with four similar gilt shell spoons, London 1819,**

the salts each designed as a scallop shell bowl with rocaille, shell and scroll shaped rim, spiral scroll and uproll handle thumbpiece, raised on a turtle foot, the spoons each with scallop shell bowl, handle stem entwined with a sinuous serpent and flaring terminal with a female mask with flowing hair
