Early 20th century diamond and onyx tortue wristwatch by Cartier, Paris c.1915,

silvered, signed 'CARTIER' and with black Roman numerals, blued steel hands, two row calibre onyx and rose cut diamonds to the bezel, millegrain set, the platinum case with gold panel at the back, French assaymarks, serial numbers to back of case 12071 and 10591, workshop mark for Edmond Jaeger the Cartier watchmaker, diamond scroll shoulder lugs securing the similarly set onyx and rose cut diamond expanding bracelet, formed of calibre onyx bars between sprung loaded rose diamond side bar links, mounted in platinum, French marks
