



Charles II silver engraved tumbler cup, London 1683, maker's mark WF conjoined (Jackson p.140), probably by William Francis,

circular tuck-under form, engraved to one side with an armorial shield with three scallop shells within crossed scrolling plumes.

Arms of Littleton / Lyttelton, Pillaton branch. This tumbler would have been made during the era of Sir Edward Littleton, 2nd Baronet (c.1632-1709) and his son and heir, Edward, who did not take the title having predeceased his father.
