



Charles II silver engraved tumbler cup, London 1683, maker's mark WF conjoined (Jackson p.140), probably by William Francis,

circular tuck-under form, engraved to one side with an armorial shield with three scallop shells within crossed scrolling plumes.

Probably arms of Littleton / Lyttelton, possibly Pillaton branch.
