Pair of 19th century micromosaic and gold hoop panel earrings, c.1840, probably Italian, the tapering ovals with a beetle and trailing flowers in blues and reds on a white ground,

the flowers diminishing to a slender dotted line, blue and white chevron rim, close set in gold with a double ropetwist band border, back-hinged fittings, French control marks (for gold items of imported or unknown origin)
