Late 19th century sapphire and diamond cross pendant, English c.1890,

of Latin form, the arms set each with a line of end-to-end oblong cushion cut sapphires, an oval faceted sapphire to the intersection point, spaced around the edge with old brilliant cut diamond accent stones in crimped collet settings on a knifebar wire frame, similar forming trefoil diamond cluster to each arm terminals, the sapphires claw set, mounted in gold
