



Pair of early 20th century sapphire bead and pearl pendant earrings by Cartier, Paris, c.1910, each hung with a polished oval sapphire bead of dome cabochon form, sapphire caps above, from a line of small white pearls having a small round sapphire bead to the middle, from pointed-dome cabochon cut sapphires, collet set, French gold hallmarks,

partial workshop mark for Georges Lenfant and serial number _5889, unsigned, accompanied by an Expertise Report from Olivier Bachet, no'd OB2209 declaring that the earrings are a genuine Cartier item and discerning the serial number to be SL5889
