

Early 20th century emerald and diamond brooch by Caldwell, American c. 1910 , of shaped rectangular form, centred by a principal old round brilliant cut diamond in diamond foliate cluster, to a four-row emerald line ground, channel set with square cut stones, outer line border of single cut diamonds, millegrain set in platinum, signed 'JEC \& Co', serial number possibly Z8072, the principal diamond approximately 1.25 ct
