Victorian pearl and diamond cartouche cluster tiara, English c.1890, converting to a necklace, formerly belonging to the Earl of Perth,

graduated to the front with a row of fleur-de-lys style foliate cartouche cluster motifs centring four pearls in and around a cushion diamond, each with a pearl and diamond arc between, mounted in silver and gold, together with clasp for wearing as necklace and tiara fitting

Length around as tiara 38cm / 15"

Height at front (excluding frame) 6cm / 2 3/8"

Height at back 1.2cm / 1/2"

Length as necklace 40cm / 16"
