Late 18th century diamond flowerhead cluster ring c.1790, probably originally a button, the circular panel slightly domed and set with six pear cut diamond petals, around a cushion cut diamond centre and to a ground of smaller cushions, the scalloped edged border with lacey trios of diamond accents, close cut down collet set in silver, on a later gold reeded shank with bifurcated shoulders and gold under bezel
Diameter 2cm / ¾"

Central diamond spread approximately 4.5 x 4.3mm
