19th century emerald and diamond cluster, c.1880, mounted as a ring,

the circular flowerhead design centred by a cushion cut emerald of emerald-cut, raised above a uniform petal border of eight pear shaped emeralds, to a rose cut diamond ground, the scalloped petal edge with calibre cut emerald accents, mounted in gold, the later gold ring with bifurcated shoulders featuring a leaf motif, detaching upon a tool, approximately 2.35cts of emeralds in all
