Early 20th century pique-jour enamel and diamond butterfly brooch, c.1905, converting for wear as either a diadem or a hair comb,

the wings in moss-green pique-jour enamel with diamond set rims and accents to the iridescent enamel markings in blue, orange and purple, the abdomen in diamond and purple enamel, faceted ruby eyes, a pear shaped diamond to each antennae, mounted in gold with platinum to the diamonds all of old cut, together with a fitted case with stamp for English jewellers Hall & Co
