Pair of 19th century gold and turquoise fringe pendant earrings, French c.1870,

each with an openwork pear shaped panel studded with a graduated curve of round cabochon turquoise, upon a black enamel and rose diamond trefoil surmount and hung below with five articulated gold batons featuring oval turquoise terminals and suspended in a tiered formation, all from round gold panel tops with single round turquoise, French 18ct gold assaymarks to earring fittings and to each fringe baton
