of uniform shape, each arm formed of single pear shaped peridot, a square step cut peridot to centre with a small cushion cut diamond accent at each corner, the stones claw set to a scroll carved gallery, simple circular ring suspension bale, with a fitted case featuring stamp for London & Ryder of 17 New Bond Street
