Antique peridot, white enamel and 18ct gold pendant chain necklace, c.1890, with fancy hexagonal cut peridots,

the largest suspended to the front from a creamy-white double-C scroll and fleur-de-lys motif surmount featuring an old cut diamond to centre, three smaller peridot above spaced by further similar enamelled double-C scroll motifs, the peridots all coronet claw set, upon a fine chain of long oblong links alternating tracelink sections and with gold ball spacers, baton clasp, panel to back '18C' and testing as 18ct gold

Length open 46cm / 18"

Drop at front 4cm / 1 1/2"
