Art Deco diamond lovebirds and fountain brooch by Cartier, Paris, the geometric design reminiscent of Pliny's doves,

featuring two fan-tailed birds perched either side of a classical two-handled urn on stepped base, their heads stooping as if to drink, the birds set with pear and triangular cut stones, the urn basin of inverted dome form and pave set with single cut diamonds, pierced to the basin underside in manner of fluting, the birds stood upon the upright scroll handles, stepped baguette diamonds forming the base and stepped diamonds forming a stylised geometric fountain effect, collet set and mounted in platinum, signed 'CARTIER', serial number 02362 (twice), French platinum assaymark, approximately 2.75cts of diamonds in all
