the two-rows of five petals set throughout with diamonds of old brilliant, cushion, double eight and single cuts, around a circular faceted emerald dotted around by five rose cut diamond collet accents, open set in silver and gold, Austrian 'A' control marks, approximately 4.75cts of diamonds in all
