Late 19th century five stone ruby and diamond cluster ring, possibly French, c.1890, with cushion cut rubies totalling approximately 2.00cts,

in a rose cut diamond scalloped line border, cut down collet set in silver and gold, open set to the rubies, split shouldered gold shank with later liner, testing as 18ct, trace of possible French eagle's head mark for 18ct

Cluster width at centre 10.4mm

Central ruby 6.3 x 5.3 x 2.2mm

Weight: 4g
