



19th century cushion diamond cross pendant, c.1880, of Latin form,

the arms formed of eleven old cushion cut diamonds, largely uniform and with slightly larger diamond to centre, in open cut down collet settings, hung upon a five stone diamond line suspension loop, mounted in silver and gold, approximately 11.50cts in all (including the central diamond of approximately 1.30ct)
