



Early 20th century three stone emerald and diamond ring, c.1910, central emerald-cut Colombian emerald of rectangular form, approximately 1.30ct,

flanked by old pear cut diamonds oriented point-outward, to a fancy pierced and miligrain foliate scroll mount set with old single and brilliant cut diamonds, mounted in platinum, the pear diamonds approximately 1.20cts together and the remainder of the diamonds approximately 0.50cts, accompanied by (PDF scan of) AGL report no. 1151939 for the emerald giving a Colombian origin opinion and that it shows insignificant traditional clarity enhancement
