Early 20th century sapphire and diamond chain necklace and cross pendant, c.1905,

the cross of Latin form with a central line of calibre cut sapphires, bordered by rose cut diamonds, the sapphires within a gold channel and the diamonds millegrain set in platinum all with a gold back, hung from a detachable sapphire line and gold suspension loop, upon a calibre sapphire and diamond collet chain necklace, formed of small round diamond collets alternating small three-stone square sapphire and diamond mini-bow links, featuring a square cut sapphire collet with round cut diamond above and below in petal-shaped collets, the diamonds to the chain all of old and transition brilliant cut, open set and mounted in platinum, approximately 2.00cts of diamonds in all
Length of cross pendant including suspension loop 3.4cm / 1 3/8"
