Late 18th / early 19th century diamond and coloured gem harlequin cluster ring, c.1800,
formed as a cross of five cushion cut diamonds spaced by cushion cut sapphire, emerald and a yellowy
gem possibly topaz and pink stone possibly pink sapphire or spinel, close cut down collet set in
individual collets, bifurcated foliate-engraved scroll shoulders, triple line below to a double reeded
shank, mounted in silver and gold
