**Italian 18ct vari-coloured gold and diamond floral panel cuff bracelet by Cazzaniga, Rome, with repeating fancy raised floral spray to each panel,**

in bold relief each with S-scroll stem supporting leaves and three flowerheads in full bloom and with a budding flower to top, all in yellow, rose, lemon and white gold upon a stipple textured ground, the white gold leaves clustered around the stem within the ground and each inset with a small single cut diamond highlight, the sprays chased and engraved, the panels articulated forming a flaring cuff and with scalloped upper edge, opening on a pushbutton clasp collet set in gold with oval faceted ruby, workshop mark for Cazzaniga to clasp, testing as 18ct.

Cazzaniga:

From the 1940s, Angelo Giorgio Cazzaniga began to design jewels that represented a synthesis between artistic elements belonging to different epochs and cultures: Renaissance, Byzantine, Baroque and Oriental. Incorporating a complexity of design and decoration in golds and colored stones as a tribute to movement and vitality.
