19th century floral and foliate rose tiara, English c.1840, centred by a tremblant five-petalled bloom in the form of a stylised dog rose, featuring a light yellow cushion cut diamond to centre, approximately 2.50ct,

the petals around having a two row border pave set with lines of cushion, old mine and rose cut, flanked by leafy stems with smaller similar rose flowerheads, open collet and cut-down collet set throughout with old mine, cushion, brilliant and double-eight cut diamonds, mounted in silver and gold

Height at front excluding frame 4.3cm / 1 1/4" (Height including frame 6cm / 2 1/4")

Length around 23cm / 9"

Frame length 28cm / 11"
