Late 19th century diamond, purple enamel and gold pansy brooch-pendant, c.1890, with diamond line rims,

enamelled in lilac-purple to the upper petals and to the lower petals shading lighter to centre, decorated with naturalistic markings, the centre claw set with an old European cut diamond, the edges set along with small old round cut diamonds, hinged pendant loop to verso and brooch fitting, all mounted in gold, approximately 1.75cts of diamonds in all (including the central diamond of approximately 0.35ct)
