Late 19th century cabochon emerald and diamond three stone ring, c.1890, inset to a broad gold band, the central pyramidal cabochon cut Colombian emerald of square cushion outline, of approximately 3.50 - 4.00ct,

flanked by old European cut diamonds, the gold mount tapering in a continuous line from the head to the back of the shank, the diamonds approximately 1.00ct each, accompanied by AGL report no.1155605 giving a Colombian origin opinion for the emerald and that it shows insignificant to minor traditional clarity enhancement
